

ORDINANCE 2020-35
VILLAGE OF BUCKEYE LAKE

AN ORDINANCE TO TRANSFER FUNDS FROM THE MAYOR'S COURT AGENCY FUND IDENTIFIED FOR DISPATCH SERVICE TO THE POLICE DEPARTMENT CONTRACTUAL SERVICES FUNDS FOR MARCS SERVICES AND THE DECLARATION OF AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, in 2015 Licking County officials were discussing the possibility of charging municipalities for police dispatching services; and

WHEREAS, in October 2015 the fiscal and/or mayor's court clerk began allocating Five Dollars and No Cents (\$5.00) from fine money collected on each case; and

WHEREAS, Licking County officials decided not charge the Village of Buckeye Lake for dispatching services but the Five Dollars and No Cents (\$5.00) continued to be allocated from fine money and is now in an agency fund;

WHEREAS, a check for the accumulated funds, through April 30, 2020, for Five Thousand Twenty Dollars and No Cents (\$5,020.00) was issued to Licking County but not sent as no payment for police dispatch services is due;

WHEREAS, such funds being previously identified for police communications should now be allocated for police communications;

NOW THEREFORE, be it resolved by the Council of The Village of Buckeye Lake, at least two-thirds (2/3) of its members concurring to dispense with the requirements of charter section 4.04 requiring three readings on three separate days with at least one week between the readings:

Section I. The check issued from that agency fund to Licking County for police dispatch service, for Five Thousand Twenty Dollars and No Cents (\$5,020.00) shall be voided and the monies returned to the agency fund, 9901.

Section II. The Six Thousand Fifteen Dollars and No Cents (\$6,015.00) identified for police dispatching services in agency fund 9901 shall be transferred to Police Department Fund 2905 for use for MARCS radios or other dispatch related services.

Section III. For the reasons in the preamble, this Resolution is declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, safety, morals, and welfare of the citizens of Buckeye Lake. This resolution shall become effective upon its passage.
