WHEREAS, it is necessary to revise and/or establish additional estimated revenue for Village Expenditures, and

WHEREAS, this Ordinance constitutes an emergency measure providing for the daily operations of all Municipal Departments.




SECTION I. Additional Estimated Revenue in the Capital Projects Fund (4203) in the amount of \$999,940.00. New revenue is from the OPWC Loan for the North Bank Rd – East Stormwater Improvements.

SECTION II. This ordinance is passed as an emergency and shall take effect at the earliest possible time permitted by law.
