ORDINANCE 2020-47

AN ORDINANCE PROVIDING FOR ADDITIONAL ESTIMATED REVENUE FOR THE VILLAGE OF BUCKEYE LAKE FOR THE CALENDAR YEAR 2020 AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, it is necessary to revise and/or establish additional estimated revenue for Village Expenditures, and

WHEREAS, this Ordinance constitutes an emergency measure providing for the daily operations of all Municipal Departments.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF BUCKEYE LAKE, COUNTY OF LICKING, STATE OF OHIO, AND DECLARING IT AN EMERGENCY THAT:

SECTION I. Additional Estimated Revenue in the State Grants – Cultural Project- Pavilion Fund (2062) in the amount of \$125,000.00. New revenue is from a State Grant from the Ohio Facilities Construction Commission.

SECTION II: The General Fund shall advance \$125,000.00 to the State Grant - Cultural Project – Pavilion Fund to provide for the ability to secure funds from the Ohio Facilities Construction Commission. This amount will solely be an advance, and is not a transfer. The advance shall be repaid from the State Grant as funds become available, but not to exceed 12 months.
