ORDINANCE NO. 2020-50

AN ORDINANCE AWARDING THE BID FOR THE VILLAGE OF BUCKEYE LAKE NORTH BANK RD EAST STORMWATER IMPROVEMENTS PROJECT AND AUTHORIZING AND DIRECTING THE MAYOR TO EXECUTE THE CONTRACT BETWEEN THE VILLAGE AND SAID CONTRACTOR SUBJECT TO FUNDING.

WHEREAS, the Village of Buckeye Lake has received bids for what has been termed as the Village of Buckeye Lake North Bank Rd East Stormwater Improvements Project; and

WHEREAS, the consulting engineer has recommended that the bid be awarded to Kendrick Excavating.

THEREFORE, FOLLOWING AN AFFIRMATIVE VOTE OF AT LEAST TWO THIRDS (2/3) OF THE COUNCIL TO DISPENSE WITH THE REQUIREMENT OF THE BUCKEYE LAKE VILLAGE CHARTER SECTION 4.04 TO READ AN ORDINANCE ON THREE SEPARATE DAYS WITH AT LEAST ONE WEEK BETWEEN READINGS,

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF BUCKEYE LAKE, STATE OF OHIO:

SECTION I: That the bid of Kendrick Excavating. for the Village of Buckeye Lake North Bank Rd East Stormwater Improvements Project is hereby APPROVED as attached Exhibit "A", and the contract is hereby awarded to said successful bidder.

SECTION II: That the mayor be, and hereby is, directed to execute said agreement with Kendrick Excavating for base bid amount of \$834,410.80 pending funding.

SECTION III: This ordinance shall take effect and be in force at the earliest date allowed by law.
