

VILLAGE OF BUCKEYE LAKE

ORDINANCE NO. 2021-03

AN ORDINANCE AWARDDING THE BID FOR THE VILLAGE OF BUCKEYE LAKE MILL DAM CONCRETE AND ELECTRICAL PROJECT AND AUTHORIZING AND DIRECTING THE MAYOR TO EXECUTE THE CONTRACT BETWEEN THE VILLAGE AND SAID CONTRACTOR SUBJECT TO FUNDING AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, the Village of Buckeye Lake has received bids for what has been termed as the Mill Dam Concrete and Electrical Project; and

WHEREAS, after receiving closed bids, the company ProCon Professional Construction Services Inc. has been recommended to receive contract.

THEREFORE, FOLLOWING AN AFFIRMATIVE VOTE OF AT LEAST TWO THIRDS (2/3) OF THE COUNCIL TO DISPENSE WITH THE REQUIREMENT OF THE BUCKEYE LAKE VILLAGE CHARTER SECTION 4.04 TO READ AN ORDINANCE ON THREE SEPARATE DAYS WITH AT LEAST ONE WEEK BETWEEN READINGS,

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF BUCKEYE LAKE, STATE OF OHIO:

SECTION 1: That the bid of ProCon Professional Construction Services Inc. for the Village of Buckeye Lake Mill Dam Pavilion Project is hereby APPROVED, and the contract is hereby awarded to said successful bidder.

SECTION 2: That the mayor be, and hereby is, directed to execute said agreement with ProCon Professional Construction Services Inc. for Concrete and Electrical bid in the amount of \$27,398.00.

SECTION III: This ordinance shall take effect and be in force at the earliest date allowed by law. That in order to protect the health, safety, and welfare of the citizens of the Village of Buckeye Lake in that to provide for the expedition of construction at time funds are released, and the ability for engineering service to be completed within the time frame provided by the grant administrator, this Ordinance is declared to be an emergency measure and it shall become effective on its passage and signature of the Mayor.
