## ORDINANCE NO. 2021-20 VILLAGE OF BUCKEYE LAKE, OHIO

## AN ORDINANCE TO DISPOSE OF UNNEEDED AND OBSOLETE ITEMS THAT ARE OWNED BY THE VILLAGE OF BUCKEYE LAKE, OHIO, AND THE DECLARATION OF AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, the Village of Buckeye Lake, Licking County, Ohio has ownership of a number of unneeded and obsolete items which are no longer needed or used for the operation of the village; and

WHEREAS, it is the desire of the Village to dispose of these items by either donation to an outside governmental entity, non-profit entity, internet auction, or by disposal in the trash; and

**WHEREAS**, at the First Reading of this Ordinance, the Council determined, by unanimous roll call vote, the need to dispose of this property as expeditiously as possible was necessary and amended this Ordinance, declaring it an emergency, suspending, all rules related thereto, and then by unanimous roll call vote, adopted this Ordinance, as now amended;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE LEGISLATIVE AUTHORITY OF THE VILLAGE OF BUCKEYE LAKE THAT FOLLOWING AN AFFIRMATIVE VOTE OF AT TWO-THIRDS (2/3) OF THE COUNCIL TO DISPENSE WITH THE REQUIREMENT OF THE BUCKEYE LAKE VILLAGE CHARTER TO READ AN ORDINANCE ON THREE SEPARATE DAYS,

<u>Section 1:</u> The mayor is hereby authorized to take steps reasonable and necessary to dispose of all the items listed in attached Exhibit A.

Section 2: Each section and each part of each section of this Ordinance is hereby declared to be an independent section or part of a section and, notwithstanding any other evidence of legislative intent, it is hereby declared to be the controlling legislative intent that if any such section or part of a section, or any provision thereof, or the application thereof to any person or circumstances, is held to be invalid, the remaining sections or parts of sections and the application of such provision to any other person or circumstances, other than those to which it is held invalid, shall not be affected thereby, and it is further declared to be the legislative intent that the other provisions of this Ordinance would have been adopted independently of such section, sections or parts of a section so held to be invalid.

Section 3: That this Ordinance shall take effect and be in force immediately after its passage.
