

ORDINANCE NO. 2021-70
VILLAGE OF BUCKEYE LAKE

AN ORDINANCE ADOPTING THE PAY PLAN FOR 2022 – 2023 AND THE DECLARATION OF AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, the Village desires adopt a 2022-2023 pay plan; and

WHEREAS, the Personnel Committee has reviewed the proposed amendments from the previously adopted pay plan ordinances and recommends adoption of the pay plan; and

WHEREAS, in order for the proposed amendment as set forth to be enacted in a timely fashion and for the start of the 2022 fiscal year, this Ordinance needs to be adopted as an emergency;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of the Village of Buckeye Lake, at least two-thirds (2/3) of its members concurring to dispense with the requirements of Charter Section 4.04 requiring three readings on three separate days with at least one week between the readings:

SECTION I: That the Village of Buckeye Lake 2022 – 2023 Pay Plan, attached as Exhibit A, is hereby adopted.

SECTION II: That it is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of this Council and that all deliberations of this Council, and any of its committees that resulted in such formal action, were in meetings open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements of R.C. §121.22.

SECTION III: That this Ordinance, for the reasons in the preamble, is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, safety, morals, and welfare of the residents of the Village of Buckeye Lake, for which reason the Council hereby declare this Ordinance an emergency measure and it shall take effect and be in force immediately upon passage.
