RESOLUTION NO. 2021-16 VILLAGE OF BUCKEYE LAKE THIRD READING

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE PARKS AND RECREATION COMMISSION TO OVERSEE AND ADMINISTER NEWLY ACQUIRED PARKS PROPERTIES.

WHEREAS, the Village of Buckeye Lake, Ohio, is organized under the laws of the State of Ohio and (Home Rule) of the Ohio Constitution, pursuant to the Village Charter; and

WHEREAS, the Village recently acquired a building at Ryan Braden Park, 118 Third Street; and

WHEREAS, the Village recently completed construction of the Pavilion, 10500 Mill Dam Road, and

WHEREAS, the Village Charter, Section 7.03(e), charges the Parks and Recreation Commission to "equip, operate, direct and maintain all the existing recreational facilities and park facilities...";

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of the Village of Buckeye Lake, at least a majority of its members concurring:

SECTION 1: The building acquired by the Village at Ryan Braden Park, 118 Third Street, shall now be considered part of said park and the Parks and Recreation Commission is charged with equipping, operating, and maintaining this facility.

<u>SECTION 2:</u> The Pavilion constructed by the Village at 10500 Mill Dam Road shall now be considered part of said park and the Parks and Recreation Commission is charged with equipping, operating, and maintaining this facility.

SECTION 3: That this Resolution shall be effective at the earliest date provided by law upon its passage.
