RESOLUTION NO. 2022-04 VILLAGE OF BUCKEYE LAKE, OHIO

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING AND DIRECTING THE MAYOR TO APPLY TO THE OHIO DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION FOR TRANSPORTATION ALTERNATIVES PROGRAM (TAP) FUNDING, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, The Village of Buckeye Lake is eligible to apply for Transportation Alternatives Program funding for the Village of Buckeye Lake Connectivity Improvement Project; and

WHEREAS, Transportation Alternatives Program funding applications are due by January 31, 2022;

NOW, THEREFORE, be it resolved by the Council of the Village of Buckeye Lake, State of Ohio.

<u>SECTION 1</u>: That the Mayor for the Village of Buckeye Lake be and herewith is authorized and directed to apply to the Ohio Department of Transportation for Transportation Alternatives Program funds.

SECTION 2: That said request shall be for improvements to connect sidewalks, multi-use paths, improve drainage, and install bicycle signage on Walnut Rd. (SR 79) from North Bank State Park to Church & Stewart Ave., estimated to cost approximately \$1,300,000.00.

SECTION 3: This Resolution is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety, and therefore will become effective upon its date of passage and approval by the Mayor, provided that it receives the affirmative vote of two-thirds (2/3) of the members elected to the Council of the Village of Buckeye Lake; otherwise, it shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
