RESOLUTION NO. 2022-16 VILLAGE OF BUCKEYE LAKE

A RESOLUTION ACKNOWLEDGING PAYMENT FOR WORK DONE TO VILLAGE PROPERTY BY PROPERTY OWNER STEVE SCHILLING AND THE DECLARATION OF AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, the Village of Buckeye Lake, Ohio, is organized under the laws of the State of Ohio and (Home Rule) of the Ohio Constitution, pursuant to the Village Charter; and

WHEREAS, the Village Public Service Committee has approved reimbursing neighboring property owner for repair and improvement work completed on village owned property; and

WHEREAS, Property owner Steve Schilling had submitted an invoice for \$3880.00 and requested that, in leu of payment, he would like a Water Tap Fee forgiveness,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of the Village of Buckeye Lake, at least two-thirds (2/3) of its members concurring to dispense with the requirements of Charter Section 4.04 requiring three readings on three separate days with at least one week between the readings:

SECTION 1: The Village of Buckeye Lake Council Approves a one-time reimbursement payable to Steve Schilling in the amount of \$2500.00 to be drawn from General Fund appropriations.

SECTION 2: For the reasons of prompt payment and efficient accounting, this Resolution is declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, safety, or welfare of the citizens of the Village of Buckeye Lake and therefore, this Resolution shall become effective upon its passage by Council.
